2023 RHY National Grantee Training

The Family and Youth Services Bureau's (FYSB) 2023 Runaway and Homeless Youth (RHY) National Grantee Training took place November 28-December 1, 2023 in Seattle, Washington. The training included 964 attendees (902 in-person) across all 10 regions. This infographic highlights the event feedback from 251 overall feedback forms and 3.114 individual session feedback forms.

Four in ten (39%) reported 5 years or less experience working with youth experiencing homelessness.



Three out of four (76%) respondents were in leadership roles.




